Frequently Asked Questions



1. Will transportation be provided for students?

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent.

2. Are EC students eligible for the Character Academy?

Yes, however, principals should use their knowledge of the specific student and their needs prior to making a recommendation.

3. How will parents be involved in the Character Academy?

It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that the student completes all program requirements outlined in the Program Agreement. For example, parents will arrange transportation for their child to and from The Character Academy each day after school and assist their child in completing 10 hours of community service at a local community agency. In addition, the Character Academy Coach will offer parent education sessions throughout the year.

4. Will there be a middle school component?

At this time, The Character Academy is only available to high school students.

5. What happens if my child does not complete all of the components of The Character Academy?

Students who do not complete all components of the program will complete a disciplinary re-assignment at Ramsey Street High School. They will not receive credit for the time completed at The Character Academy. Students will be expected to complete the full assignment.
